From the Pastor's Desk:

Farewell to Year of the Priest.

The closing ceremony for the year of the priest took place in Rome this June, but some matters extended into the month of August. The Feast of St. John Vianney is on August 4th every year and he continues to be the model for all priests in parishes. If there is one thing that stands out in his life, it is the notion of "Conversion."

He himself went through a conversion, leaving the military and deciding to become a priest. Does this sound familiar? St. Ignatius of Loyola also went through a conversion from being a soldier to being a disciple of the Lord.

For the year of the priest, every priest needed to go through a type of personal conversion or spiritual awakening to their identity. It is hard to avoid the split that seems to be showing up between two approaches to priesthood:

- 1) A priesthood that sees the priest as "Alter Christus" with the priest being presented as the agent of Christ to the people. In the liturgy this priest is the only one active, while the people are passive. And this priest is the conduit of the Holy Spirit through the Sacraments. Access to God is controlled through this priest.
- 2) A priesthood modeled after Jesus at the Last Supper, where he gets up and washes the Disciples' feet. This priest is not so much the agent of Christ to the people, but rather the Christ Savior who speaks to the Father on behalf of the people. Remember the older position of the priest at Mass. He faced toward the altar and heaven. He was talking to God the Father on behalf of the people behind him. This is still true today in the Eucharistic Prayer, "Father calling to mind the death your son endured for our salvation..." This priest prays to the Father for and in the name of the community. The prayer of Jesus to the Father was, "that they may be one as You and I are one."

After Saint John Vianney became responsible for the Ars community, a parishioner followed him into the church quietly. What he saw surprised him. Vianney was face down on the floor of the church praying for his people, "My God, grant me the conversion of my parish. I am willing to suffer all my life...even for a hundred years. Only let my people be converted."

Hebrews Chapter 5 starts out, "Every high priest has been taken out of mankind and is appointed to act for men in their relations with God,...That is why he has to make sin offerings for himself as well as for the people."

Comunidad Hispana del Valle de Skagit

Vigésimo Primer Domingo en el Tiempo Ordinario
22 de Agosto, 2010

La lectura de hoy de Isaías describe a los Israelitas trayendo sus ofrendas al Señor “en vasos puros.” El regalo de mí mismo—mi perseverancia paciente y mi fidelidad a la voluntad de Dios—es tan importante como la ofrenda monetaria que ofrezco.

Carta del Pastor: El Año del Sacerdote Termina

La ceremonia cerrando el Año del Sacerdote se celebró en Roma en junio, pero algunas cosas se extendieron a este mes de agosto. La Fiesta de San Juan Vianney es el 4 de agosto cada año y el sigue siendo el modelo para todos los sacerdotes de parroquias. Lo que más nos quiso dejar fue la idea de “Conversión”.

El paso por una conversión, dejando el militar para ser sacerdote. Le suena conocido? San Ignacio de Loyola también se convirtió en discípulo del Señor después de haber sido soldado.

En el año del sacerdote, cada sacerdote necesitaba haber pasado por una conversión personal o un despertar espiritual a su identidad. Es difícil ignorar la diferencia entre dos modos de enfocarse en el sacerdocio:

1. Un sacerdocio que ve al sacerdote como “Alter Christus” con el sacerdote presente como agente de Cristo para la gente. En la liturgia solo el sacerdote está activo mientras la gente está pasiva. Este sacerdote es el conducto del Espíritu Santo a los Sacramentos. Acceso a Dios está controlado por el sacerdote.
2. Un sacerdocio modelado como Jesús en la Santa Cena, cuando se levanta a lavarle los pies a los Discípulos. El sacerdote no es el agente de Cristo a la gente, más bien es Cristo Salvador quien habla con el Padre de parte de la gente. Recuerden que antes durante Misa el sacerdote estaba volteado al altar y al cielo. Él hablaba con Dios el Padre de parte de la gente detrás de él. Todavía vemos esto en la Oración Eucarística, “Padre, recordando que tu Hijo murió por nuestra salvación...” El sacerdote ora al Padre por y en el nombre de la comunidad. La oración de Jesús al Padre era, “que sean uno como Tu y Yo somos uno.”

Después de que san Juan Vianney se hizo responsable por la Comunidad Ars, un feligrés lo siguió silenciosamente a la iglesia. Lo que vio lo sorprendió. Vianney se postro boca abajo en el suelo de la iglesia y oró por su gente, “Dios mío, concédeme la conversión de mi parroquia. Estoy dispuesto a sufrir toda mi vida...hasta cien años. Solo deja que mi gente sea convertida.”
